An average days' wages in Swaziland is less than \$1 USD. Within the first week after being trained Teen Challenge Swaziland sold over \$3,500 worth of jewelry. AIDS is Devastating Swaziland

Over the last five years, the population of Swaziland has decreased from 1.3 million to 856,000 due to the AIDS virus. The average life expectancy is only 39 years. More than fifty percent of females between the ages of 15-24 are infected. If this death rate continues the nation's population will be nearly wiped out within one generation leaving just a holy remnant.

About The "Lighthouse" Teen Challenge Swaziland

The "Lighthouse" is truly a light to the nation of Swaziland reaching out to the poor, brokenhearted, abandoned, diseased, and desperate. They have two residential rehabilitation programs for males and females, a Teen Challenge leadership school, a preschool, medical center, community outreach programs, three church plants, and twenty homes that care for 120 abandoned children. *On the right, Kevin Ward, Executive Director of Teen Challenge Swaziland holds up a necklace made by one of the trainees.*

Musa Today

When Musa was only a few months old his father was shot and killed during a war in Mozambique. His alcoholic mother moved to Swaziland so she and her children could live on the streets and beg. Musa started using drugs and by the age of 13 was desperate for help. He was addicted to drugs and taking care of his sister's infant son, Bongi. Musa and Bongi were both rescued by The "Lighthouse." Today, Musa serves as a staff member at Teen Challenge and Bongi continues to live in a loving Christian home for abandoned children with his foster Mom.
