My life was full of fear, rejection and shame. I put everything else in my life before God. When my 14 year old son, Joshua, had been killed that what little strength and faith I had seemed to die with him.

I turned completely away from God and turned to drugs and destructive relationships with men. Meth use took me to some of the darkest places you could ever imagine. I finally cried out to God in desperation.

He told me to let everything go and I came into Teen Challenge. Now I am experiencing God's love, forgiveness, and freedom from so much.



Mongolia Update

From 1995 to 1997, Michelle and I served in Mongolia where we taught at a Bible school and helped plant churches.

When we first arrived in Mongolia they had just got done translating the New Testament into Mongolian and they still did not have the Old Testament translated yet. Half the population were nomadic herdsman and women who lived in tents with no running water and no electricity.

One of the first church plants was in an area called Ulaangam, in the Westernmost part of Mongolia. Miraculously, within 48 hours we were able to purchase a building, register it with the local government and build benches that could seat up to 75 people and also had a room to serve as a parsonage for the Pastor, a 21 year old young woman named Migamurasen. This new church was the first registered Christian church recognized by the government since Communism had fallen.

The third evening we held our first service and the place was packed. Everyone who came, young and old, accepted Jesus! It was awesome. The next day, a middle aged women who had given her heart to the Lord asked me a question I will never forget. She asked,

"Has anyone else in the world ever heard about Jesus or are we the only ones?"

I was so happy to tell her that she was one of the last people to hear about Jesus, that nearly everyone in the world has heard. She was so excited to have found a Savior that she wanted others to know about Him too!

Recently, at a mission's convention in Winchester, Virginia, a couple living in Mongolia informed me that the church in Ulaangam is still being pastored by Migamurasen and it opened the door for other Christian churches throughout Mongolia to be registered and officially recognized by the government. As a result, missionaries can now openly conduct their missions work and receive visas.
