

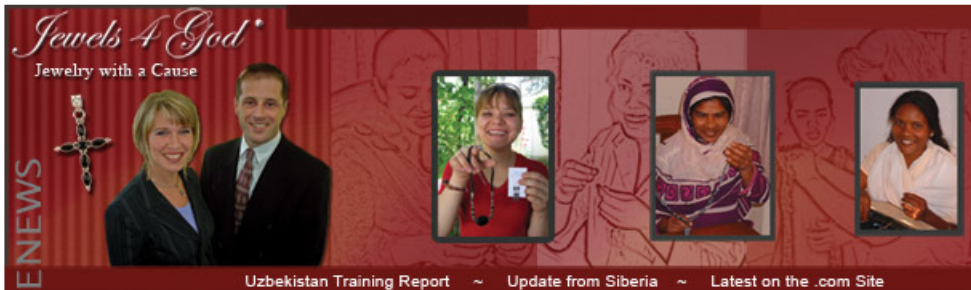

We were privileged to train three different organizations helping the less fortunate in Uzbekistan.

Teen Challenge Uzbekistan reaches out to the drug addicts of Uzbekistan helping them to become physically well, spiritually alive, mentally sound, emotionally whole, and socially adept.



An organization that has over 60 volunteers who care for nearly 400 mentally and physically handicapped children at an orphanage. Sixty of the children are bed ridden. The volunteers help the children by providing all kinds of therapy - music, drama, physical, art, massage, motor skills, etc. Most importantly, they are showing them the practical love of their Creator - bathing, feeding, and caring for them.

Meet One of Our Trainees

Sergei started drinking at the age of 16, and soon became a terror to his family. He stole from the house, constantly fought with his parents, and embarrassed them in front of his relatives. During one fight, he pushed his father down the stairs which resulted in his father's leg being broken.

Finally, Sergei's mother Svetlana had enough. When Sergei came home drunk, she poured a can of gasoline on him and pulled out a match. Sergei's screams brought the neighbors, who pulled Svetlana away. Her only hope was that Sergei would die of liver failure, and put an end to her misery.

Sergey entered Teen Challenge in 2005 at the advice of a friend, and his entire life transformed. After completing the program, he went through training to become a counselor and teacher. He now serves on the staff of Teen Challenge and is married to a beautiful wife who is expecting their first child.

Most importantly, he and his mother have not only forgiven each other but but they have a wonderful relationship. Each night after our training, "Momma" Svetlana invited Michelle and I for dinner with Sergei, and their family. Momma says, "I cannot even describe with words the pain we went through with Sergei's addictions; neither can I describe the joy that I have for the freedom my son found in Teen Challenge because of Jesus!"
